Public Hearing on ZBA-142: Robert Trenkle of 14485 Williams Dr., Elk Rapids, MI 49690, Tax Parcel No. 05-06-175-031-00 is requesting a 28.0' variance from the front yard setback adjacent to the Williams Drive property line for the construction of a house and attached garage. The property line is a front yard, and the required setback is 50'. The request would provide a 22.0' front yard.

The applicant/representative speaks on this request. Applicant Robert Trenkle approached the microphone to explain why he is requesting this variance. A summary of his comments are outlined below:

- He has owed this property for a long time and now has the opportunity to build on it.
- He tried to be in compliance with the Zoning Ordinance and even purchased extra property, but because of the lot constraints and the wetlands behind his property, he needs this variance.
- Mr. Trenkle shared recent photographs of his property to give the ZBA members a straight visual of his property from the street.
- Mr. Trenkle noted that after he cleared his property, Ms. Keri Kent, EGLE visited the lot and found a larger wetlands area than previously reported. Instead of a 76'-80' from the road, it is now changed to 60' from the road.

Committee Members ask applicant/representative questions:

- Zoning Administrator Nix noted when applicant Trenkle changed his measurements due to the expanded wetlands; he was measuring from the road instead of his property line. Once this was pointed out, Mr. Trenkle recognized he measured wrong and would need a larger variance.
- Zoning Administrator Nix and the ZBA Board members determined because of the newly expansive wetlands, Mr. Trenkle will need to increase his original variance request. It was noted that the Board would not be able to grant a variance greater than the one requested at this public hearing.
- This new variance request will need to be re-noticed and another public hearing meeting to address an increased variance would need to be scheduled.
