## Elk Rapids Township Planning Commission Meeting Meeting Minutes – May 16, 2023

The meeting of the Elk Rapids Township Planning Commission was called to order by Chairperson Shen Smith at 1:30 PM at the Government Center, 315 Bridge Street, Elk Rapids, MI 49629.

**Public Hearing – Elk Rapids Township Zoning Ordinance Amendment 2023-01:** Amend Elk Rapids Township Zoning Ordinance Chapter 8, R-2 Residential – One Family and Two-Family Zone by adding Section 8.08, Conversion of an Existing Permitted or Special Exception Use.

Larry Nix stated the 7 criteria which are being considered for the stated conversion use are.

- 1. A minimum of forty thousand (40,000) square feet of lot area.
- 2. Setback requirement as per the R-2 Zone district.
- 3. Paved parking area with a minimum of 2 parking spaces per 2-bedroom unit, and 1 parking space per 1 bedroom unit.
- 4. The parking area shall be screened from view from the adjacent public or private street.
- 5. The building must maintain the character of other single-family dwelling in the area in terms of entry doors and architectural characteristics.
- 6. The number of proposed living areas or dwellings shall not exceed 50% of dwelling units permit in the R-3 district on the subject parcel.
- 7. No existing single family dwelling unit shall be converted within this zone unless the Planning Commission has determined that the proposed use will not be injurious to surrounding neighborhood and not contrary to the spirit and purpose of this Ordinance.

Larry Nix went on to explain that there is an interest by the owner of Cherry Suites to convert the existing residence and that the Planning Commission has proposed this amendment to consider such an application. Bill Derman commented that the amendment was well done, and Chairperson Smith agreed.

Action will be for Sabty to send to the County Planning Commission the approved Amendment. Discussion by Derman of timing of the next meeting, with the understanding that the County will hold special meetings as needed for the coming months. Sabty will try to find out when the County meeting will be scheduled, if the County does not act within the 30 days, the Planning Commission will then be able to go ahead with seeking the Twp Board approval. Sabty will be sending a letter to the County on May 17, 2023, with copies to the designated recipients.

## **Township Zoning Administrator Report (Larry Nix) Nothing additional**

**Township Legal Staff Report (Bill Derman)** – Mr. Derman gave brief update on the following:

- Library Deed, The deed is now completed with the Village.
- Short Term Rentals there is nothing new to report.
- Sewer SAD Township is filing a market study for 13 parcels, 70 REU agreement with the Village, just not finalized yet.
- Tart Trail Presentation at Townline Cider Works June 15, 2023 5-7pm. Public Welcome, discussion to involve Maple Bay to Elk Rapids trail extension.
- HERTHA windows Installing 3 new windows to match the existing to maintain the historic nature intact for future grants.
- Farmland Preservation nothing new to report.
- Orchard View Progress waiting to review final documents and expect construction to begin this summer.
- Traverse City Horse Show Open House Thursday, May 25, 2023 at 5:30 PM.
- Michigan is last state to have a sewer bill, however there are 2 bills now being reviewed.
- Bill Derman gave an update on the average age in Antrim County with the population at 23,431. He also commented that the majority of the County revenue comes from the west side of the County, however that side does not receive reflective services.
- Also, discussed was the inequity of costs to the farmers to supply comparable fruit products to the market. Some are changing to Fun Farms and offering experience related activities.
- State of Michigan to hold PRE Audits in 76 Counties.
- Bill in the works that will allow tribal marijuana businesses on tribal land.

**Unfinished Business:** Continuation – Cherry Suite request for change in use.

- Larry Nix will continue to work with Cherry Suite for an acceptable application and a hearing setup.
- There will be no June Meeting.
- Sabty will post a hearing notice once the date is determined.
- Considering the Cherry Suite's pending permit, the Commission will be flexible with the
  continuation of the pending public hearing with results of the Amendment 2023-01 with
  the Township and County. The next Planning Commission meeting will be July 11<sup>th</sup> or
  the 18<sup>th</sup>.

## Other Items Discussed:

- Master Plan discussion as follows:
- Amos agreed with Smith that any new roads will be at the expense of the developer and should be added on page 23.
- Sabty reminded members that the additional R-3 6 lots (sites) need to be added to the
  text of the Master Plan as the lots are already in the Future Land Use map. Sabty has
  adjusted the information of income of the township using the 2020 census. Copies were
  distributed to the members.
- Discussion of the Master Plan Hearing meeting date was discussed and agreed that there is no deadline for completion before the end of the year.

## **New Business:**

- Planning Commission Physical Review Tour of Township Parcels
  - 1. Smith has announced dates available for tours of Township parcels, could be in May, however it appears that an August timeline may be better for the Commission.
  - 2. Township Board members are also interested. Discussion of areas and time will be discussed at a later date.
